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Summary

I build applications end to end: the front end with React and Next.js on TypeScript, the back end with Python and FastAPI or with Node. I also run my own infrastructure — Linux, Docker, a server at home and a VPS, where I keep my projects live — and I work with AI and language models, both putting them inside the applications and automating part of the development itself with agents.

I work on the backend of a marketplace for loans between individuals: the borrower locks bitcoin as collateral and the loan moves in USDC.

- Brought my own way of working with AI agents and automatic checks between phases into the team; it is the one I published as AgenticPromptMethod.
- Every loan closes against a fact that can be checked, and the duties are split across components: the one that watches does not decide, and the one that decides does not hold the funds.

Botanium – garden and houseplant app 09/2026 – present

An app for looking after your garden and your plants, with a bit of a game to it: you collect the species you grow. It matches your own inventory against the lunar calendar and tells you what to do each day. On the way: pest identification with models of my own. Live demo on my portfolio.

DeepPlay – an AI that learns to play poker 03/2026 – present

A long-term project: an AI that learns poker by playing against itself. Pluribus showed that this can be trained on a modest server, and I want to see how far I get. Around it sits a platform for reviewing hands. Early development.

ArmyTrading – real-time market data platform 02/2026 – present

A platform that takes in market data in real time, lets you backtest strategies against the history, and checks the risk limits before anything is opened.

AgenticPromptMethod – my own method for developing with agents 08/2026

A method for automating code development while keeping it supervised: the work is split into phases, and between one phase and the next there are automatic validation gates that check what the agent claims to have done before it is allowed to carry on.

TripMate – The Bubble Hub 04/2026 – present

An Android app for organising group trips. I am the lead developer and it is in beta.
